## PROGRAMS:

- \*The next Business in a Bag will be on Thursday, June 17; Chris Glaeser of Escalade Consulting will be the presenter.
- \*Robin Phillips of Blue Robin Communications is interested in presenting a workshop on organizing.
- \*Valerie suggested "knowing how and when to hire staff" as a future Business in a Bag topic; Trish suggested that that program be presented as a two-part workshop in July.
- \*Dick will resume charge of organizing the BB lineup.
- \*Low attendance at monthly breakfasts is still a problem; rotating locations has produced little increase.
- \*The Committee debated at some length the ideal number and type of monthly programs; the Board of Directors has long used "one morning, one noon, one night" as the monthly standard for large gatherings (not including workshops such as Business in a Bag); however, some members of the Committee favor adding an additional luncheon geared toward networking, and others have suggested discontinuing the breakfast. No definite conclusions or recommendations were reached.
- \*The Committee is still seeking a speaker for the planned "history of an entrepreneur" program. Trish suggested the manager of the Chamber's member Chick-Fil-A's.
- \*Peter suggested planning an event, perhaps a manufacturing exports seminar, to attract members to the Chamber's suggested Southwest Houston Manufacturing and Technology Alliance.

## PUBLICATIONS:

\*Peter brought a "Procurement Opportunities Guide," published by Mastercard, of which he plans to order a limited number of copies to give away first-come-first-served to Chamber members.

- \*The nature and practicalities of needed improvements to the Chamber website are still a matter of considerable debate. Dick will speak with the Board of Directors (or its Chair) about the feasibility of getting some Committee members on a website taskforce.
- \*The Chamber hopes to add links to available entrepreneurial services to the website.
- \*Trish suggested that Committee members independently research the websites of other local Chambers.
- \*The Committee plans to organize a publications subcommittee soon.
- \*Art is still in charge of converting documents to electronic format. The Committee's electronic publication plans are moving away from CDs and toward online materials.
